## **SUSPENSION OF PARTY MEMBERS WHO WORKED AGAINST THE PARTY IN 2024 PRESIDENTIAL AND PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS.**

I am writing to inform the National and Regional Party leadership and the general public that, per our party's constitution on membership Article 3 clause (9) (1) and Clause (7) (1) , we have decided to suspend certain members of our party for working against the party's interests.

Article (3) clause (9) (1) states, "A Member of the Party who stands as an independent Candidate against the officially elected member of the party or joining or declaring his or her support for another political party, or for an independent candidate when the party has sponsored a candidate in a general or by election automatically forfeits his or her membership of the party."

According to article (3) Clause (7) (1)," A Member may be suspended from membership of the party, or holding any office in the party, pending an enquiry into his or her conduct by a Disciplinary Committee."

Among other allegations from their polling stations,

1. Some of them worked for independent candidate to the extent of being party agents for one of the independent candidate at the special voting center.
2. Worked for the NDC candidate to the extent of some of them proudly calling our party's candidate after declaration informing him they made him to lose.
3. Spread falsehood against the party's candidate.


