

POLICY WORK.

Redefining the Status Quo:

1. DEBATE AND OPEN FORUM PRIOR TO THE RELEASE OF THE BUDGET AND THE USE OF THE RESOURCES THIS WOULD INVOLVE CONSTRUCTIVE CRITITSCISM FROM ALL AVENUES AND SECTS OF PEOPLE ON CAMPUS.

- This seeks to enhance student participation from the determination of what the budget would be used for and, through this, there would be full awareness of what the representative council would use the monies allocated for through suggestions and debates by members of the university body – this will be a clear sign of inclusivity.

2. SET UP A MONTHLY REFERENCE OF PROGRESS IN RESPONSES TO THE ISSUES THAT PEOPLE FACE

- We seek to integrate into the culture of the UGSRC, a periodic update of the work of the src. Through this, students will be well informed about the current and potential activities that the s has and would be embarking on. This will also serve as a means for the leadership to communicate with the people and reveal the hinderances faced in the process to deliver on the promises and what the alternative mechanism would be deployed.

3. SET UP A LONG-TERM STRUCTURE

- **BUILDING A LONG- TERM STRUCTURE FOR THE SRC**
 - **INFRASTRUCTURE (GOALS FOR EVERY ADMINISTRATION, SUCH THAT BY THE END OF EVERY ADMINISTRATION, THEY ARE GIVEN THE CHANCE TO ALSO FOCUS ON NEW THINGS THAT THEY DESIRE TO DO)**
 - **ACADEMIC (PROVISION OF ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS BY THE ACADEIC COMMITTEE , PROVISION OF COMBINED SLIDES BY ALL DEPARTMENTS ,**
 - **SPORTS AND SPORTSMEN CARE – SRC SUPPORT FOR ALL SPORTSMEN**
 - **SET UP A PERIODIC SESSION WHERE MANAGEMENT SITS WITH STAKEHOLDERS ABOUT THE MOST PRESSING ISSUES (AT LEAST FROUR TIMES DURING THE TENURE)**
- **SANITATION ON CAMPUS (WASHROOMS ON CAMPUS) – RENOVATION.**
- **PLANS FOR RENOVATIONS AND MAINTENANCE (PROVIDE A MAINTENANCE STRUCTURE FOR ALL INFRASTRUCTURE THAT THE SRC HAS A DIRECT RELATION WITH)**

4. SET UP A LINK FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF GHANA TO THE VARIOUS HIGH SCHOOLS TO BE ABLE TO BUILD A BOND WITH THEM AND BRING IN MORE STUDENTS TO THE UNIVERSITY OF GHANA – This will increase the number of applicants but also serve as an early guide to all applicants and reduce the levels of ignorance and reduce the difficulty experienced during the admission process.

5. CRAFTSMEN POLICY – HOW TO GAIN THE BEST FROM OUR THEATHRE ARTS STUDENTS (PUBLICIZE THEM AND BUILD UP THE STRUCTURE FOR THE COMPLETION OF THEIR THEATRE TO MAKE IT BOTH AN EDUCATIONAL HUB AND ACOMMERCIAL HUB AS WELL. – This can also be a source of commercialization for the school and the src, through its completion, the src will help in its publicity to gain more users and share in the profit gained.

6. COVER OPEN GUTTERS – This will help to avoid littering and choking the gutters as well as serve as a form of protection from falling into them and injuring oneself. This will be done gradually such that the cost will not only be incurred by one administration.

7. ATLETHIC OVAL SET UP – Plan to renovate the athletic oval. This is important so that we reduce the usage of the main sports stadium and preserve it further.

- 8. SRC AND JCR COLLABORATION – SRC WOULD SET UP A FUND TO WORK HAND IN HAND WITH THE VARIOUS JCRS IN HALLS AND DEPARTMENTS TO RENOVATE WASHROOMS, PROVIDE CERTAIN AMENITIES THAT ARE LACKING IN THE VARIOUS JCRS TO SOLVE THE NEEDS OF THE STUDENTS IN THESE RESPECTIVE SPACES - This will help fast track projects undertaken within various departments and halls that aim at improving student life on campus.**

- 9. SET UP THE CAPACITY BUILDING HUB FOR CITY CAMPUS (DEBATE AND PUBLIC SPEAKING HUB FOR CITY CAMPUS, CITY CAMPUS MENTORSHIP HUB) – This is a hub that would facilitate SETTING UP OF A CITY CAMPUS TEAM FOR FOOTBALL BASKETBALL AND OTHER SPORTS TO INCLUDE THEM EFFECTIVELY IN THE VARIOUS SPORTS AND ASPECTS OF THE SCHOOL.**

- 10. SUPPORT FOR SPECIFIC TOURNAMENTS TO CLUBS AND SOCIETIES THAT REQUIRE FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO PARTICIPATE IN COMPETITIONS (EXAMPLE; WORLDS SCHOOL DEBATE COMPETITION)**

- 11. POLITICAL MENTORSHIP PROGRAM (UNITING THE POLITICAL PARTIES ON CAMPUS, TO BUILD A POLITICALLY UPRIGHT CAMPUS WITH ADEQUATE KNOWLEDGE ABOUT STUDENT POLITICS AND LEADERSHIP) – This is to promote unity on campus and avoid strict partisan politics.**

- 12. LEGON ENTREPRENEURS – RELEASE GRANTS TO STUDENT ENTREPRENEURS AFTER STUDYING WHAT THEY ARE INTO TO HELP THEM BOOST AND ENCOURAGE STUDENT ENTREPRENEURSHIP – The winners of the grants would be monitored and be used as an inspiration for other students to be able to start businesses on campus as well.**

- 13. FACILITATE A DISCUSSION WITH MANAGEMENT CONCERNING THE LECTURE PERIODS ON CITY CAMPUS – This would promote a mutual agreement on the treatment of students at city campus and find a lasting solution to it. Through this, the concept of city campus being lost about the reasons for their treatment would be eliminated and together, we work to promote and improve life on city campus.**
